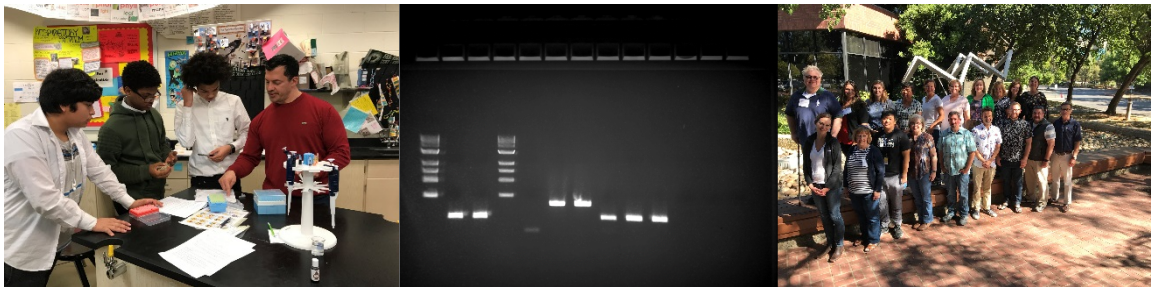


# TEACHING THE GENOME GENERATION
