

# PROGRAM OPTIONS

The Pre-Medicine to Doctor of Medicine (Pre-Med to MD) Combined Programs offer potential entry to an MD program:

- **2+4 Pre-Med to MD**  
Four semesters and two summers of undergraduate coursework + four years MD
- OR
- **3+4 Pre-Med to MD**  
Six semesters and two summers of undergraduate coursework + four years MD

At the end of the first year in the College of Medicine, qualified Pre-Med to MD students who have met the graduation requirements will be granted the Bachelor of Science (BS) Degree in Health Sciences.

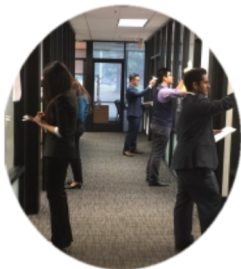

## STREAMLINED PROGRAMS

California Northstate University (CNU) offers the only Pre-Medicine to Doctor of Medicine (Pre-Med to MD) Combined Programs in the state of California. Highly motivated and goal oriented students have the opportunity to complete undergraduate and medical education in six to seven years instead of the traditional eight years.

Students complete prerequisites for admission to medical school while attending the College of Health Sciences (CHS) for two or three years and have the following benefits:

- High priority for medical school admission at CNU
- Tuition savings due to shortened time in school
- Small class sizes and guaranteed course offerings each semester
- Individualized learning plans
- Dedicated and award winning faculty advisors and mentors for each student
- Connection to College of Medicine faculty



## ADMISSION TO THESE PROGRAMS

1. Apply to the Bachelor of Science program in the College of Health Sciences (CHS)
2. Applicants who have the following academic achievements are eligible for the Pre-Medicine to Doctor of Medicine (Pre-Med to MD) Combined Programs:

3. Successfully complete the phone interview (interview is by invitation only)

Once accepted, students will complete required undergraduate coursework at the CHS campus in Rancho Cordova.

## COLLEGE OF MEDICINE ADMISSION CRITERIA

Students in these programs who meet the following criteria while taking prerequisites in the CHS will be admitted to the College of Medicine (COM) at CNU:

- Successfully complete the COM pre-requisite coursework
- Maintain a 3.5 GPA in the undergraduate program and be in good standing each semester
- Participate in at least one volunteer activity per year with the COM
- Score 510 or higher on the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT)
- Submit an application through the American Medical College Application Services (AMCAS) and a supplemental application to CNUCOM
- Satisfy COM's Technical Standards (<http://medicine.cnsu.edu/students-com/admissions>)
- Successfully complete the COM interview

The CHS will hold Mock Interviews to prepare students for the COM interview process.
