



Pre-Med Post-Baccalaureate Curriculum Plan (2018-2019)

The course plan for the Pre-Medical Post-Baccalaureate Program (PMPB) includes an optional MCAT review workshop in the summer term, academic coursework appropriate to medical sciences and preparation for MCAT, a required healthcare seminar, and elective experiential courses in fall and spring terms. All of the courses are taught on the Rancho Cordova campus with the exception of MEDS500 and MEDS510 which are held on the Elk Grove campus. Students must enroll in and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours of coursework in each semester to maintain full-time student status. A **minimum of 27 credit hours** is required to complete the entire program. For students who are studying for the MCAT in the spring semester, a lighter course load is recommended since students are expected to meet course responsibilities while studying for the exam.
