



Pre-Med Post-Baccalaureate Curriculum Plan (2019-2020)

The course plan for the Pre-Medical Post-Baccalaureate Program (PMPB) includes an optional MCAT review workshop in the summer term, academic coursework appropriate for pre-health professions students, a required careers in health sciences seminar, and elective experiential courses in fall and spring terms. All of the courses are taught on the Rancho Cordova campus with the exception of MEDS410 and MEDS420 which have components on both the Elk Grove and Rancho Cordova campuses. Students must enroll in and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours of coursework in each semester to maintain full-time student status. A **minimum of 27 credit hours** is required to complete the entire curriculum plan.

Students must choose their coursework in consultation with the academic advisor to ensure course offerings. From the courses listed below, students must meet the minimum credits requirements for each area:
