



# THE FOCUSED INTERDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH AND SCIENTIFIC TRAINING (FIRST) EXPERIENCE

This one week immersion experience for high school students focuses on conducting interdisciplinary and collaborative scientific research at the CNU College of Health Sciences state-of-the-art research facility.

- Participants will engage and collaborate with college students and distinguished faculty members by focusing on a novel scientific research question.
- While conducting research, students will participate in scientific discussions, receive training in laboratory skills, and learn about scientific rigor and methodology.
- Participants will give a professional presentation on their scientific results, with the potential for future publication.
- Areas of study may include environmental biology, chemical modeling/drug recovery, and molecular analysis of model organisms- all connecting to health and biomedical sciences.
