- Areas of study may include environmental biology, chemical modeling/drug recovery, and molecular analysis of model organisms- all connecting to health and biomedical sciences.

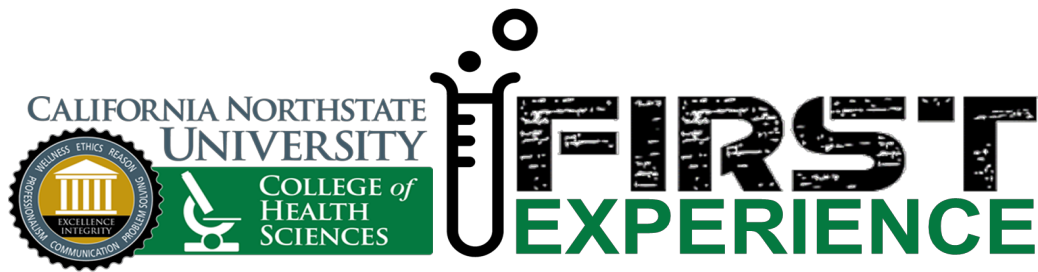
